

- Every individual is duty bound to Love Nature & contribute to it's well-being.




Extent of environmental damage by an individual



> 300,000 trees planted annually













Seed Balls for increasing the Green Cover

- Used to increase the green cover drastically in areas like near highways and other barren lands
- Scattered before the monsoon
- Has been experimented children from few schools adopted under the Sri Sathya Sai Vidya Jyothi Program with encouraging results.







Sanitation and Cleaning

- To create awareness about cleanliness
- Regularly undertaken at:
 - Streets
 - Public toilets
 - Fair venues
 - Public hospitals
 - Cremation ground
 - Temples, churches, mosques
 - Burial places







- Nation-wide
- > 5,000 Samithis carry out cleaning drives in their localities
- > 3,75,000 man hours reported each year.
- Reported figure is only about 25% of the total hours
- > 1.2 million man hours.

 >3,500 Sevadals work simultaneously

 65 km drain alongside NH 55 is cleaned every year on 1st May before the monsoon sets in.

 To prevent landslides owing to blockage of drains.
