



This report provides an overview of the organization and the activities undertaken by the members (sevadal) of the Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organisations, Nadia.

# Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organisations



The Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organisations, founded by Bhagawan Sri Sathya Sai Baba in the year 1965, is a service organisation with a spiritual core and base to benefit all mankind irrespective of religion, caste, creed or sect. The Organisation serves as a platform for its members to undertake service and other activities motivated by an urge for one's own transformation with the aim of realising one's inherent divinity.

Without any distinction of religion, nationality, race, socio-economic status, either for those who work in the Organisation or for those who are served by it, the Organisation transcends all barriers leading humanity towards the ideal of 'Fatherhood of God and Brotherhood of Man'.

The concept of fees or membership subscription is alien to the Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organisations, for there cannot be any fee or subscription for one's journey towards his own self.

The organisation functions through its primary units called as Samithis and Bhajan Mandalis of which individuals - from different strata of society, different ethnic groups pursuing different religions and faiths - are members bound by the dictum of "Love all, Serve All" and pursue their own sadhana towards self-transformation following the path of selfless service to humanity.

At no point is an individual asked to follow a certain religion or rituals. On the contrary each is inspired to follow his own faith so as to ensure that a Hindu becomes a better Hindu, a Muslim becomes a better Muslim, a Christian becomes a better Christian and so on. In fact, this spiritual basis inspires everyone to pursue his own religion better by putting into practice Love and Selflessness. That is why the Organisation features in its emblem the symbols of the major religions of the world.

*The Organisations named after Me are not to be used for publicising My Name, or creating a new cult around My worship .... They must render seva (service) to the helpless, the sick, the distressed, the illiterate and the needy. Their seva (selfless service) should not be exhibitionistic; it must seek no reward, not even gratitude or thanks from the recipients. Seva is sadhana (spiritual exercise), not a pastime of the rich and well placed.*

*You must have the firm belief that the aim of this Organisation is to remove the obstacles that keep man away from God, that separate maanavathwa (Humanity) from Maadhavathwa (Divinity).. This Organisation must elevate the human into the Divine."*

## WINGS OF THE ORGANISATION

Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organisations functions under three wings viz. (i) Spiritual, (ii) Education, and (iii) Service. Each activity in a wing is directed to facilitate and help the members in their own spiritual advancement. Although, the nature of activities undertaken under different wings appear to be distinct and dissimilar, but there is an inherent interrelationship amongst all the three wings. The three wings stand for Worship, Wisdom and Work.

Spirituality and Service are complementary to each other. Spirituality is the motivational force behind service and service is the fulfillment of spirituality. Therefore, spiritual concepts learnt through education must be put into practice in form of service to humanity. Thus, in order to successfully realise the objective of joining the Sai Organisation, one must participate in activities of all the three wings.

## ADMINISTRATION OF THE ORGANISATION

Headed by an All India President who is supported by the National Vice Presidents and State Presidents, the Organisation functions like a well-oiled machine, focused on its purpose, clear in its vision and dedicated in its efforts to live up to Swami's message "Love All, Serve All".

The Samithis and the Bhajan Mandalis constitute a genuine spiritual movement where the members are united by a common bond Love for God and Service to fellow human beings.

The members of the organisation work as one cohesive unit whether as sevadals providing service

at Prashanthi Nilayam, at medical camps, doing Narayan seva or the Bal-Vikas gurus who work with young children to imbibe in them a desire to follow the five human values of Truth, Righteousness, Love, Peace and Non-violence, or the teachers who having undergone the training in EHV help in guiding the young minds towards the higher goals of life or the Sai Youth who work tirelessly in the Sri Sathya Sai Village Integrated Programme bound by one goal of practicing the ancient dictum of "Service to Man is Service to God".

## THE 9 POINT CODE OF CONDUCT AND 10 PRINCIPLES

Every member of the Organisation is expected to undertake Sadhana (spiritual discipline) as an integral part of his/her daily life by observing by the following Nine Point Code of Conduct which has been given by Sri Sathya Sai Baba for one's spiritual and personal development. In addition, the ten principles that form the core of guidance for all the members of the Organisation as ordained by Baba himself are also produced hereunder. The nine-point code of conduct and the ten principles are fundamental to the spiritual development of the members of Sai Organisations.

### 9 Point Code of Conduct

- ❖ Daily meditation and prayer.
- ❖ Devotional singing/prayer with members of one's family once a week.
- ❖ Participation in Bal Vikas programme by children of the family conducted by the Organisation.
- ❖ Attendance at least once a month at Bhajan or Nagar Sankeertan programme conducted by the Organisation.
- ❖ Participation in community service and other programmes of the Organisation.
- ❖ Regular study of Sai literature.
- ❖ Speak softly and lovingly with everyone with whom he comes into contact.
- ❖ Not to indulge in talking ill of others especially in their absence.
- ❖ Putting into practice the principle of "Ceiling on Desires" and utilise any savings thereby generated for the service of the mankind.

### 10 Guiding Principles

- ❖ Treat as sacred the land in which you were born. Have patriotism to your nation - but do not criticise other nations or put others down. Not even in your thoughts or dreams should you think of bringing grief to your country.
- ❖ Respect all religions equally.
- ❖ Recognise humanity as one family - treat everyone as a family member - love all
- ❖ Keep your house and surroundings clean - for this will promote hygiene and health.
- ❖ Practice charity - but do not encourage beggars by giving money. Provide food, clothing, shelter and help them on other ways (do not encourage laziness)
- ❖ Never give a bribe or take bribe - never give in to corruption.
- ❖ Curb envy and jealousy; expand your vision and outlook, Treat all equally regardless of caste or creed.
- ❖ Be self-reliant. You may be wealthy and have servants to do your bidding, but service to society must be done by yourself.
- ❖ Have and cultivate 'Love for God and fear of sin'.
- ❖ Never go against the laws of the land; follow these diligently both in word and in spirit. Be an exemplary citizen.

# Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organisations, Nadia

## BRIEF HISTORY

With the divine blessings of Sri Sathya Sai Baba, the first unit of Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organisations (Bhagawan Sri Sathya Sai Seva Samithi, as was the name then) was initiated in Kalyani, Nadia by Late Mr. Tulshi Charan Ghoshal and late Mr. Anil Sarkar in Kalyani on 18th Feb of 1972 in the presence of the then State President Late Mr. Arun Kumar Dutt and respected Late Mr. G. V. Sathya Narayan the then District President of Kolkata. With the earnest devotion and initiative of Mr. Tulshi Ghoshal and Mr. Anil Sarkar, Sai bhajans started in eight devotees' houses. Along with bhajans, Nagar Sankirtan, Narayan Seva, Laksharchana (chanting names of the Lord) were the prime activities.

In 1976, Dr. Tulshi Charan Ghoshal was appointed as the first District president of Nadia. Through Swami's grace, within a few months, two other Samithi at Ranaghat and Krishnanagar came up. Mr. Gopal Mallik was the first convener of Ranaghat and Mr. Niranjan Biswas, was the first convener of Krishnanagar. During that time the dedication and active participation of Mr. P. C. Bose towards building the organisation is worth mentioning.

Gradually from 1973 onwards, various activities beginning with spiritual activities like Community Bhajan, Nagarsankirtan, Study Circle, Sadhana shibir etc started spreading out with the initiative of the samithis. Along with spiritual activities, various Seva activities like cleaning of temples, cleaning and sanitation work in religious fairs (melas), Jal Satra, hospital cleanings were started. Narayan seva and distribution of blankets to the needy during winter were also regular programmes of the organisation.

Medical camps were organized in "adopted villages" such as Uttar Chandamari near Kalyani, Pumblia village near Ranaghat, Shaner Pukur in Krishnanagar. These Samithis also organised periodic veterinary camps, blood grouping camps and blood donation camps.

Flood relief camps have been organized in Ranaghat and Kalyani on several occasions during floods in which, Sevadal distributed dry food, clothing and other relief material to the flood victims.

In November 1975, on the occasion of the 2nd World Conference of Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organisations and Bhagavan Baba's 50th Birthday, the members of the Kalyani Samiti had participated at Prashanti Nilayam and had offered a souvenir at the Lotus Feet of Bhagavan which HE had graciously blessed and signed with His Divine Hands. On the same occasion, the Bengali version of the book "Divya Vani" which had been translated by Mrs. Kalpana Roy (the in charge of mahila vibhag of Kalyani Samithi) was also released.

In 1984, when the World Sevadal Conference was held, two of our respected senior devotees from Kalyani Late Dr. Narayan Aditya Choudhury and Late Dr. Satyesh Chandra Maity had been blessed to speak on the topics of agriculture in the Divine presence of Bhagavan Baba.

Nadia district's Kalyani Samithi had the privilege of hosting a programme headed by two of Swami's senior devotees, Professor N Kasturi and Brigadier S. K Bose. They both met the devotees of the district

and gave inspirational talk on the life and teachings of Bhagavan Baba.

In 1996, the 25th anniversary of Sathya Sai Seva Samithi, Kalyani was celebrated at Vidyasagar Mancha Kalyani. Devotees from Nadia, North 24 Paraganas and Kolkata attended the whole day programme.

The all Bengal District Presidents' Meet was organized at the District Sai Centre, Kalyani on 22nd and 23rd September 2007

A Symposium on the theme of "Unity of Faith & Sri Sathya Sai Baba's teachings" was organised in 2015 to mark the 90th birthday of Baba and the 50th anniversary of the Organisation. Educationalists and senior administrative officers participated in the discussions, in the presence of a large public audience apart from Sai devotees. The movie on Swami's mission "His Work" was shown at the end. The programme was highly appreciated by the public at large.

On 17th & 18th June 2017, the 15th Mini State Conference was held in Kalyani, BCKV Lake Hall.

### District Center "Sai Prem Sadan"

"Sai Prem Sadan", the District Sai Centre situated at Kalyani, has become a hub of Seva and spiritual activities of the district

Nadia District's activities got a significant boost with the setting up of the Sai Center in Kalyani. In 1975, with the blessing of Bhagawan Baba and through the initiative of the then Joint Secretary Mr. Prasad Roy, land for the Centre was acquired on Lake Road, Kalyani. The then convener of Kalyani Samithi Mr. Satyesh Chandra Maity, Nadia who received Bhagawan's blessings in 2001 for building plan for the Sai Center, carrying the name "Sai Prem

Sadan". With the sincere efforts of devotees, the building was completed in 2005 and was graciously inaugurated by the then State President of West Bengal Sri. Shyamal Sur on 26th March 2005, in a very well-attended inauguration programme.





Since then, it has been the center of multiple activities like weekly medical center, blood donation camps, other service activities, Bal Vikas programme, Narayan Neva, district programme, spiritual activities and bhajans.

## OVERVIEW

Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organisations is functional in Nadia with members from various cross sections of society and different faiths. With 5 Samithis and Bhajan Mandalis, the Organisation serves as a platform for its members to undertake spiritual practices through its various wings such as spiritual, education and service for their own betterment.

The thrust is on self-transformation for it is only individual transformation that would ultimately lead to global transformation.



## SRI SATHYA SAI SEVA KENDRA

The Sai Center called as "Sai Prem Sadan" at Lake Road, Kalyani serves as the district head quarter and the venue for most district level programs. This center also runs various activities on a regular basis. Samithis that do not operate out of a Seva Kendra, function from the residences of the office bearers and/or members

## ACTIVITIES

The members of the Organisation are involved in various activities on regular basis which primarily includes Spiritual Study Circles, Community Bhajan, Nagarsankirtan through the spiritual wing; Bal-Vikas and Parenting programmes through the Education Wing and various service activities through the service wing. Importance is given to regular service activities as only through constant involvement in good work can self-transformation be achieved. Service activities which are regularly undertaken at Samithis for the transformation of the members and for the benefit of the society include visits to leprosy, correctional and old age homes, medical camps in villages, Narayan-seva, free coaching classes, vocational training for employability enhancement of the villagers, sanitation at public functions, fairs, and public urinal cleaning.

# Glimpses of few activities

## Sri Sathya Sai Vidya Jyoti Programme

Helping the children to study in a clean environment and in developing cultural roots and skills in them, Sri Sathya Sai Vidya Jyoti Program has been initiated in a primary school at Krishnanagar. On an average, 15 members (10 Gents, 5 Ladies) engage themselves in cleaning the adopted school and its surrounding area. A Cultural Programme organised at the School at Birnagar saw 30 children participating, with the involvement of 10 Sevadal (7 Ladies, 3 Gents).

Healthy mind and healthy body, both are important. A sports meet was organized at the Vidya Jyoti School, Krishnanagar. Prizes brought smile on the faces of little Narayanas.

Hygienic practices learnt at an early age become a life-time habit. Sevadal members (3 Gents, 7 ladies) teach some basic principles of personal health and hygiene to the school children.

## Cleaning and Sanitation

Cleanliness is next to Godliness. The Organisation in Nadia takes up multiple activities to keep the surrounding environment clean and plastic free. The activities include street cleaning, cleaning of riverbeds, public urinals and increasing environmental awareness.

Cleaning of the Churni river ghat and adjoining areas in Ranaghat is carried out by the youth of Nadia, once every month, This Seva work around this important river is carried out by 15 (on an average) youth Sevadal. Our Sevadal also participate in street cleaning in Kalyani.

## Blood Donation Camp

Often, people in urgent need of blood are put to considerable difficulty in getting blood. Blood donation is a life-saving service.

A blood donation camp was organised at Narayanpara, Ranaghat where 31 individuals donated blood.

## Old Age Home Visit

Sevadal members and devotees regularly visit three old age homes and spend quality time with the inmates, tending to their physical and mental needs, aided by devotional singing and other activities

## Narayan Seva

A monthly Narayan Seva is conducted in the Pumplia village which is adopted by the District. On an average, about 100 Narayanas of all ages partake the cooked food lovingly served by the Sevadal.

## National Narayan Seva

Uncooked food items are offered to 30 old and needy Narayanas every month under the National Narayan Seva Programme in Pumplia (SSSVIP Village), Krishnanagar town, Kalyani.






