Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organisations – an Introduction



The Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organisations, founded by Bhagawan Sri Sathya Sai Baba in the year 1965, is a service organisation with a spiritual core and base to benefit all mankind irrespective of religion, caste, creed or sect. The Organisation serves as a platform for its members to undertake service and other activities motivated by an urge for one's own transformation with the aim of realising one's inherent divinity.

Without any distinction of religion, nationality, race, socio-economic status, either for those who work in the Organisation or for those who are served by it, the Organisation transcends all barriers leading humanity towards the ideal of 'Fatherhood of God and Brotherhood of Man'.

The concept of fees or membership subscription is alien to the Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organisations, for there can not be any fee or subscription for one's journey towards his ownself.

The organisation functions through its primary units called as Samithis and Bhajan Mandalis of which individuals - from different strata of society, different ethnic groups pursuing different religions and faiths - are members bound by the dictum of "Love all, Serve All" and pursue their own sadhana towards self-transformation following the path of selfless service to humanity.

At no point is an individual asked to follow a certain religion or rituals. On the contrary each is inspired to follow his own faith so as to ensure that a Hindu becomes a better Hindu, a Muslim becomes a better Muslim, a Christian becomes a better Christian and so on. In fact, this spiritual basis inspires everyone to pursue his own religion better by putting into practice Love and Selflessness. That is why the Organisation features in its emblem the symbols of the major religions of the world.

"The Organisations named after Me are not to be used for publicising My Name, or creating a new one. You must have the firm belief that the aim of this Organisation is to remove the obstacles that keep

WINGS OF THE ORGANISATIONS

The Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organisation functions under three wings viz. (i) Spiritual, (ii) Education, and (iii) Service.

Each activity in a wing is directed to facilitate and help the member in his own spiritual advancement. Although, the nature of activities undertaken under different wings appear to be distinct and dissimilar, but there is an inherent interrelationship amongst all the three wings. The three wings stand for Worship, Wisdom and Work.

Spirituality and Service are supplementary and complementary to each other. Spirituality is the motivational force behind service and service is the fulfillment of spirituality. Therefore, spiritual concepts learnt through education must be put into practice in form of service to humanity. Thus, in order to successfully realise the objective of joining the Sai Organisation, one must participate in activities of all the three wings.

ADMINISTRATION OF THE ORGANISATION

Headed by an All India President who is supported by the National Vice Presidents and State Presidents, the Organisation functions like a well-oiled machine in the District under the stewardship of the District President, focused on its purpose, clear in its vision and dedicated in its efforts to live up the Swami's message – "Love All, Serve All".

The Samithis and the Bhajan Mandalis constitute a genuine spiritual movement where the members are united by a common bond – Love for God and Service to fellow human beings.

The members of the organisation work as one cohesive unit, whether as sevadals providing service at Prashanthi Nilayam, at medical camps, doing Narayan seva or the bal-vikas gurus who work with young children to inspire in them a desire to inculcate the five human values of Truth,

Righteousness, Love, Peace and Non-violence, or the teachers who having undergone the training in EHV help in guiding the young minds towards the higher goals of life or the Sai Youth who work tirelessly in the Sri Sathya Sai Village Integrated Programme and Sri Sathya Sai Vidya Jyoti Programme—each of them are bound by one goal— "Service to Man is Service to God".

THE 9 POINT CODE OF CONDUCT AND 10 PRINCIPLES

Every member of the Organisation is expected to undertake Sadhana (spiritual discipline) as an integral part of his/her daily life by abiding by the following Nine Point Code of Conduct which has been bestowed by Baba for one's spiritual and personal development. In addition, the ten principles that forms the core of guidance for all the members of the Organisation as ordained by Baba himself are also produced hereunder. The nine point code of conduct and the ten principles are fundamental to the spiritual development of the members of the Sai Organisations.

9 Point Code of Conduct

Daily meditation and prayer.

Devotional singing/prayer with members of one's family once a week.

Participation in Bal Vikas programme by children of the family conducted by the Organisation.

Attendance at least once a month at Bhajan or Nagar Sankeertan programme conducted by the Organisation.

Participation in community service and other programmes of the Organisation.

Regular study of Sai literature.

Speak softly and lovingly with everyone with whom he comes into contact.

Not to indulge in talking ill of others especially in their absence.

Putting into practice the principle of "Ceiling on Desires" and utilise any savings thereby generated for the welfare and betterment of the poor and needy.

Never go against the laws of the land; follow these diligently both in word and in spirit. Be an exemplar.

BRIEF HISTORY

By the blessing of Swami, Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organisation in WASHIM District was established on Date 1st July 1998. It was led from the front by Fifty devoted and dedicated predecessors who have been dearest to our loving Baba. Dr.D.R.Bhagwat, Mr. S.K.Satpute, Mr.V.R.Dixit, Mr. Vyanktesh Pathak, Mr. B.M.Gore, Mr.S.N.Deshmukh, were the key devotees who initiated Organisation in the District. Dr. D.R.Bhagwat played a crucial role to install the Lord Sri Sathya Baba in the heart of Devotees and had given a place for the Samiti in his residence.

Initially 30 male and 20 female devotees were bounded in the rope of pure love of Bhagvaan Baba and carried out activities like singing Bhanjan and Nagarsankirtan in the District. They have not only taken the Organisation to great heights, but also set an example for many people to follow and to get inspired. They were the role models for the youth, children and will continue to be so for the future generation also. As we had taken over this responsibility, we sincerely seek their blessings and guidance so that we shall be able to give justice to the legacy they have left behind. At present, in WASHIM the Organization has 17 Samithis, 02 Bhajan Mandalis and 760 devotees. Members are dedicatedly organizing several medical camps and are serving the society enthusiastically.

OVERVIEW

Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organisations is functional in Washim with members from various cross sections of society and different faiths. With around 17 Samithis and 02 Bhajan Mandalis, the Organization serves as a platform for its members to undertake spiritual practices through its various wings such as spiritual, education and service for their own betterment.

SAI CENTRES

Sri Sathya Sai Gramin Seva Kendra was registered in the Town Malegaon on 30-12-2007 in the name of Sri Sathya Sai Book & Public Trust Maharashtra to take up intense activities of all the three wings activities of the Organisation (Spiritual, Service and Educational) in villages to benefit the rural & poor. This center is situated 20 km away from Washim City. Total area of the

center is 1147 Square meter. Plot no is 41/1. Hall No 1 Well Constructed area 30x50 Square Feet, Hall No 2 Well Constructed area 40x25 Square Feet, Room No 1 is Well Constructed area 14x12 Square Feet, Room No 2 Well Constructed area 11x9 Square Feet, Toilet & Bath area 25x9 Square Feet remaining plot is open space. utmost care has been taken to ensure that it meets all the needs of the village community, Organizational activities and also provide aesthetically pleasing looks. This Centre will be equipped with many features like,

- a) Health Care b) Edu care c) Socio Care d) Spiritual Care
- e) Agri Care f) Veterinary Care g) Women empowerment
- h) Vocational guidance to youth i) Environment care

This service center has been changing the lives of the villagers and gradually the villagers are tuned to do self-less service .The youth and elders from this village, voluntarily participate in the Service at Prashanti Nilayam Ashram as a thanks-giving gesture to their beloved Master Sri Sathya Sai Baba for having blessed them with this village service center. ACTIVITIES:



Glimpses of Activities

Ashadhi Dindi Padyatra

Maharashtra the Santbhumi (land of saints) is known for its great historical saints and Gods. Pandharpur is the home of devotion. On the occasion of Ashadi ekadashi pilgrims from all over Maharashtra gather at pandharpur amounting to millions and the pilgrims start walking towards pandharpur for nearly a month before ashadi and get the fortune of lord vitthala's Darshan on ashadi.

In a similar way, around 1400 devotees of our Sai vitthala from across Maharashtra gathers at Dharmavaram for the Dindi Padyatra every year. After performing Sai palkhi puja on the saphami day, the padayatra starts its journey towards Puttaparthi on the next day morning. The procession headed towards Parthy in a most disciplined manner where the Gents and Ladies chant the name of Sai by singing Bhajans

First day halt use to be at a village called basampalli and they use to sing the kirtans there in the night. They started their further journey towards parthi on next day morning after the breakfast. After halting at kottacheruvu on 2nd day, the pilgrims reaches at Prashanti nilayam ashram a day before aashadi ekadasi. At the entrance of Ashram, Trustees and All India President use to receive the Palkhi and do a pooja before Lord Ganesh Mandhir. Then on the Aashadi day, the palkhi use to be taken in Sai Kulwant Hall and presented before Sai Vittala in the most traditional way with Dance ,Abhangs & Bhajans which use to be a wonderful scene to witness and seeking the blessings of Sai Vittala in Sai Kulwant Hall.

The devotees were filled with joy and gratitude after having the darshan of sai vittala.



Mother and Child care

The relation between a mother and her child is an ideal example for a blissful and unconditional relation, just like our beloved swami and us. To add more beauty , ladies sevadals from washim samiti visit 3 villages every week and discuss with mothers about how to build a great future of their children with the sanskars (Righteous teaching) and make them better and a responsible citizen. Vaccinations are also performed and precautions about various diseases were also explained. Various camps like blood checkup, hemoglobin checkup camps were also organized.

3 schools from washim District were adopted under SSSVJ project and 1 school from melghat region was also adopted, which is 100% tribal area and the people there are very poor and cannot afford education.

The students were given stationary, school uniform and other necessary material. Medical checkups were organized in schools and proper guidelines to overcome malnutrition were also given.





Mission Melghat

In Amaravti Distrit of western vidarbha, there is a place known as Melghat, a sacred land in the dense rainy forest. The residents here are totally korku tribals which are too poor and without any infrastrucuture.

These people had no source of income, no farms for cultivating and no daily wages and hence it was challenging for them to arrange even the two times meal a day. Government schemes were also not reaching them and they were so poor that they didn't have proper clothes to wear.

In such a situation, with Swami's Blessings' an initiative called MISSION MELGHAT Seva was taken by Akola zone in which sevadals visited there along with Doctors two times a month. Many hours were spent in travelling because these people lived too far away from towns.

In every visit, medical camps were organized and Amrut kalash along with proper clothes were distributed. Narayan seva was done and they were given blankets and other daily usage items.

They had such a poor financial state, that they couldn't even dream of any luxury life. Day to day survival was a challenging task for them and were surrounded by many types of diseases. In such situations, SSSSO gave them a helping hand and helped them to maintain a proper sustainable living.



Bye bye malnutrition

As the sevadals visited melghat every fortnight, they could see the children with their bodies naked and were worstly affected by the malnutrition and their body shape was changed abnormally. The main reason behind the attack of malnutrition was the lack of nutrition, proper food and health consciousness. In such situations SSSSO helped them with medicine, nutritious food and were given guidelines about maintaining proper health. As a result, the children were free from malnutrition .





Sri Sathya Sai Drinking water project

Vidarbha region in state of Maharashtra is specially known for its draughts and washim District is no exception to it. People have to roam miles in fetch of water and still there is no guarantee that they will get water. People would risk their lives in search of sacred water. Villages in washim District had faced worst draught last year. People had no choices. SSSSO Washim took an initiative to help these people and started potable water supply to 8 villages in the District with a tanker of 10k capacity. The 8 villages were Vakalwadi, Kalakamtha, Medshi, Sonkhas, Dodki, Malegaon, Ramnagar zopadpatti and kata village. 80 liters of water was served to each family and there were approx. 300 families per village. So overall 2400 families were blessed with drinking water every week. The people in the villages had a great and adorable smile while receiving the water. The water was more important and amrut for these people.

सत्यसाई साई सेवा संघटनेने उद्भवलेल्या पाणीटंचाईवर मात करण्यासाठी स्वयंस्फूर्तीने पुढाकार घेतला. यामाध्यमातून एप्रिल महिन्यापासून आजतागायत

टँकरद्वारे पुरविले जाणारे पाणी भरताना महिला.

वाकळवाडी, मेडशी तांडा, मालेगाव, सरस्वती नगर, गांधीनगर, दोडकी, रमाई नगर झोपडपट्टी, काटा आदी ठिकाणी लाखो लिटर पाण्याचा पुरवठा केला. यासाठी संघटनेकडे १० हजार लिटर क्षमतेचे टँकर असून काटा या गावातून वामनराव देशमुख हे त्यासाठी आपल्या कुपनलिकेचे मोफत पाणी पुरवत आहेत. या उपक्रमावर आतापर्यंत दीड लाख रुपये खर्च झाल्याची माहिती संघटनेचे डॉ. राजेश देशमुख यांनी दिली.

दरम्यान, संघटनेच्या

सेवेकऱ्यांकडून टँकर गावात लागताच पाणी भरण्यासाठी गावकऱ्यांची मोठी झुंबड उडत असल्याचे पाहावयास मिळत आहे. प्रतीकुटूंब ९० ते १०० लीटर याप्रमाणे पाणी पुरविले जाते. गावकरी देशमुख एका रांगेत तथा शांततेत आपली पाण्याची गरज भागवत असल्याचे डॉ. देशमुख यांनी सांगितले. तथापि, तहानलेल्यांच्या तृष्णातृप्तीसाठी सत्यसाई सेवा संघटनेने घेतलेल्या या भूमिकेप्रती त्यांचे सर्वत्र कौतुक होत आहे.

Sai Jal Seva project is in working since 2007 at Washim bus stand for past 12 years, a quality drinking water is being served to the passengers. This year the system was upgraded with a premium RO water filter. Generally, in summers, the temperature of Washim city reaches till 46 to 47 degrees and SSSSO is serving daily to almost 3000 passengers with filtered and chilled drinking water.



One Focus to vision

Many eye camps were conducted in various villages of Washim District, in which eye checkups were performed and patients were selected for the surgery. Total 549 patients were operated in the group of 10 patients per day. IOL- intra ocular lens were fitted in their eyes and black glasses along with one-month medicine was also provided.

The patients were given a vision to see the beautiful world in the second innings of their lives with Swami's Abundance Grace.
