Our district has been conducting Narayan Seva continuously for the last many decades without break and few Devotees have been in the forefront in this noble Seva. The purity of these dedicated Seva Dals were vouched through the manifestations of Vibhuti during food preparations and many such miracles are a regular feature, prompting many youngsters to join in. Medical camps are yet another activity that has been conducted every Sunday and along with Allopathic medicines, Homeopathy and Vibronics consultations and medicines are also given during these camps. Bal Vikas classes, Yoga Classes are routine features as also special hospital service programs like tea and snacks Seva.

Along with the regular activities of Medical Camps, Narayana Seva and Bal Vikas classes, the district has adopted two schools under the Sri Sathya Sai Vidya Jyoti project and a college where it runs the “Life is a game, Play it” program. Under the Vidya Jyoti project, value education classes, yoga, music lessons and skills in art and crafts are imparted to the children along with classes in computer literacy. Periodic sports and literary competitions are conducted and winners awarded and talent nurtured. The annual day function of the district was celebrated in a grand manner involving the Vidya Jyoti children where skit and musical programs were orchestrated and presented by the children themselves and was truly magnificent. Glimpses of these and other events are presented here, along with the pictures of our other seva activities.

The district is also in the forefront in identifying children who are in need of support for school education. Many girl children were given financial assistance to complete their studies while a boy was fully sponsored for his one year paramedical course. Also, financial support was extended to people hit by natural disasters and the district contributed handsomely for the relief activities for the Kerala flood victims.

Prasanthi Seva is one activity in the annual calendar that is looked forward to with much enthusiasm and joy. Ghaziabad district has always been the number one district to send maximum number of Seva Dals to the divine abode, Prasanthi Nilayam, year after year. This is made possible only by the liberal sponsoring of train tickets by Devotees.

The district has a ((Divine abode)), a permanent Sai Centre, where regular bhajans, Satsangs and Seva activities are conducted. Ghaziabad is one of the few districts to be bestowed with such a rare privilege and we all are truly indebted to Bhagawan for His blessings. We present a few glimpses of our year long activities at the lotus feet of our Beloved Bhagawan and pray that He accepts this humble offering of love of his children, from Ghaziabad.

Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organisations – an Introduction



The Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organisations, founded by Bhagawan Sri Sathya Sai Baba in the year 1965, is a service organisation with a spiritual core and base to benefit all mankind irrespective of religion, caste, creed or sect. The Organisation serves as a platform for its members to undertake service and other activities motivated by an urge for one's own transformation with the aim of realising one's inherent divinity.

Without any distinction of religion, nationality, race, socio-economic status, either for those who work in the Organisation or for those who are served by it, the Organisation transcends all barriers leading humanity towards the ideal of 'Fatherhood of God and Brotherhood of Man'.

The concept of fees or membership subscription is alien to the Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organisations, for there cannot be any fee or subscription for one's journey towards his own self.

The organisation functions through its primary units called as Samithis and Bhajan Mandalis of which individuals - from different strata of society, different ethnic groups pursuing different religions and faiths - are members bound by the dictum of "Love all, Serve All" and pursue their own sadhana towards self-transformation following the path of selfless service to humanity.

At no point is an individual asked to follow a certain religion or rituals. On the contrary each is inspired to follow his own faith so as to ensure that a Hindi becomes a better Hindu, a Muslim becomes a better Muslim, a Christian becomes a better Christian and so on. In fact, this spiritual basis inspires everyone to pursue his own religion better by putting into practice Love and Selflessness. That is why the Organisation features in its emblem the symbols of the major religions of the world.

"The Organisations named after Me are not to be used for publicising My Name, or creating a new cult around My worship....They must render seva (service) to the helpless, the sick, the distressed, the illiterate and the needy. Their seva (selfless service) should not be exhibitionistic; it must seek no reward, not even gratitude or thanks from the recipients. Seva is sadhana (spiritual exercise), not a pastime of the rich and well placed.

You must have the firm belief that the aim of this Organisation is to remove the obstacles that keep man away from God, that separate maanavathwa (Humanity) from Maadhavathwa (Divinity). The Organisation

WINGS OF THE ORGANISATIONS

ADMINISTRATION OF THE ORGANISATION

Headed by an All India President who is supported by the National Vice Presidents and State Presidents, the Organisation functions like a well-oiled machine in the District under the stewardship of the District President, focused on its purpose, clear in its vision and dedicated in its efforts to live up the Swami's message – "Love All, Serve All".

The Samithis and the Bhajan Mandalis constitute a genuine spiritual movement where the members are united by a common bond – Love for God and Service to fellow human beings.

The members of the organisation work as one cohesive unit, whether as sevadals providing service at Prashanthi Nilayam, at medical camps, doing Narayan seva or the bal-vikas gurus who work with young children to inspire in them a desire to inculcate the five human values of Truth, Righteousness, Love, Peace and Non-violence, or the teachers who having undergone the training in EHV help in guiding the young minds towards the higher goals of life or the Sai Youth who work tirelessly in the Sri Sathya Sai Village Integrated Programme and Sri Sathya Sai Vidya Jyoti Programme – each of them are bound by one goal – "Service to Man is Service to God".

THE 9 POINT CODE OF CONDUCT AND 10 PRINCIPLES

Every member of the Organisation is expected to undertake Sadhana (spiritual discipline) as an integral part of his/her daily life by abiding by the following Nine Point Code of Conduct which has been bestowed by Baba for one's spiritual and personal development. In addition, the ten principles that forms the core of guidance for all the members of the Organisation as ordained by Baba himself are also produced hereunder. The nine point code of conduct and the ten principles are fundamental to the spiritual development of the members of the Sai Organisations.

9 Point Code of Conduct

- ❖ Daily meditation and prayer.
- ❖ Devotional singing/prayer with members of one's family once a week.
- ❖ Participation in Bal Vikas programme by children of the family conducted by the Organisation.
- ❖ Attendance at least once a month at Bhajan or Nagar Sankeertan programme conducted by the Organisation.
- ❖ Participation in community service and other programmes of the Organisation.
- ❖ Regular study of Sai literature.
- ❖ Speak softly and lovingly with everyone with whom he comes into contact.
- ❖ Not to indulge in talking ill of others especially in their absence.
- ❖ Putting into practice the principle of "Ceiling on Desires" and utilise any savings thereby generated for the service of the mankind.

10 Guiding Principles

- ❖ Treat as sacred the land in which you were born. Have patriotism to your nation - but do not criticise other nations or put others down. Not even in your thoughts or dreams should you think of bringing grief to your country.
- ❖ Respect all religions equally.
- ❖ Recognise humanity as one family - treat everyone as a family member - love all
- ❖ Keep your house and surroundings clean - for this will promote hygiene and health.
- ❖ Practice charity - but do not encourage beggars by giving money. Provide food, clothing, shelter and help them on other ways (do not encourage laziness)
- ❖ Never give a bribe or take bribe - never give in to corruption.
- ❖ Curb envy and jealousy; expand your vision and outlook, Treat all equally regardless of caste or creed.
- ❖ Be self-reliant. You may be wealthy and have servants to do your bidding, but service to security must be done by yourself.
- ❖ Have and cultivate 'Love for God and fear of sin'.
- ❖ Never go against the laws of the land; follow these diligently both in word and in spirit. Be an exemplary citizen.


Historical Note on Ghaziabad District

For the state of Uttar Pradesh, in its Tryst with Divinity, our Beloved Bhagawan approved the foundation of the Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organization in the state in the year 1960. Uttar Pradesh in those times had a geographical spread encompassing areas which are presently in the state of Uttaranchal. Bhagawan's Devotees were spread across the cities of Gorakhpur, Lucknow, Ghaziabad, Meerut and Roorkee, Dehradun, Nainital, Muzzafarnagar & Saharanpur. In the year 1968, Shri Dau Dayal Gupta, an ardent Devotee of Swami, based out of Meerut, was appointed by Bhagawan as the trust convenor of 'Bhagawan Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organisation' (BSSSSO) for the state of U.P. In the early 60s and 70s, Shri D D Gupta was instrumental in establishing BSSSSO in Ghaziabad by creating a samithi in the city, ably supported by an extremely dedicated and devote group of families residing in Ghaziabad such as Chadhas, Bhatias, Nangias, Sahays, Chands, Chawlas and Swamis. In the year 1963, Shri Davinder Chadha was appointed as the 1st Convenor of the samithi whereas Shri Paresch Dutt based out of Gorakhpur, was appointed as the State President & the City of Gorakhpur spearheaded the state's spiritual & seva Initiatives. Annual and bi-annual Visits to Prasanthi saw the above Dedicated Group of families residing in Ghaziabad city actively Volunteering & participating in seva, the pinnacle of which was undertaking seva at the Gokulam, under construction in 1968. The period of early 70's witnessed the entire spectrum of spiritual, educational and seva activities being established in the city with weekly bhajans, bal vikas and seva activities. The city of Ghaziabad thus became the fulcrum of Sai activities for a widespread area comprising of Modinagar, Hapur, Bulandshahr, Moradabad, Khurja, Sahibabad & Noida. In the early 70s, various seva initiatives such as smokeless chulhas, soak pit toilets, street lighting projects and adopted village road Construction activities were undertaken with full vigor and devotion. A census of Devotees was also carried out and a directory published, Inter College Debating Competitions organised by BSSSSO Became a much-anticipated annual event In the Year 1974, Ghaziabad was given the stature of a District and Shri Davinder Chadha was nominated as the 1st District President. It Was Shri D D Gupta & Shri Davinder Chadha's earnest desire that a 'Sai Centre' be established in the district and a proposal for the same was placed at the Lotus feet of our Beloved Bhagawan. Swami in his divine magnanimity blessed the initiative and thus the residence of Shri Davinder & Smt Swadesh Chadha was ordained by living divinity to be blessed with his temple. In answer to the prayers and devotion of the Devotees residing in Ghaziabad city, Swami consented to visit the city in the year 1982 while enroute to Rishikesh for laying the foundation stone of the institute there. There is a very interesting parable shared by the Devotees with respect to the above visit, which is as follows: The original plan of Swami's visit to Rishikesh was for him to travel from New Delhi to Dehradun by a helicopter, and thereafter by road to Rishikesh. However, Swami insisted that the call of his Devotees compelled him to travel by road and he indicated that enroute, he would be stopping over at 'the residences of Chadhas'. The group travelling with Swami were mystified as to why Swami was referring to a single stop-over at Ghaziabad in plural. What unfolded was that Swami, other than visiting the residence of Shri D & Swadesh Chadha at Ghaziabad also made a brief halt, enroute to Rishikesh at the residence of Shri Rajkumar and Smt Nirmala Chadha, residing at the retreat no 10, Civil lines, Roorkee. The day of 9th April 1982 saw divinity in all its physical splendour arriving at 'Sai Kripa' located at 120, East Model town. To this day, this center continues to hold weekly bhajans & Bal vikas classes.

Post Bhagavans Visit to The City there was a resurgence of Devotion and Noida Samithi was established. Swami personally nominated Sh Davinder Chadha to membership of the UP Trust along with Sh Rajesh Khanna ji. In the Year 2006 in accordance with the mandate of the Central Trust basis a long overdue request by Devotees Residing in Districts adjoining New Delhi to be administratively aligned to Delhi State Ghaziabad State was emerged From U.P and made a part of Delhi State. In its new avatar the District has gone from strength to strength adding three Samithis i.e Indirapuram, Sahibabad 1 and Sahibabad 2 to it's fold bringing the total to 5.



ACTIVITIES

The members of the Organisation are involved in various activities on regular basis which primarily includes Spiritual Study Circles, Community Bhajan, Nagrsankirtan through the spiritual wing; Bal-Vikas and Parenting programmes through the Education Wing and various service activities through the service wing. Importance is given to regular service activities as only through constant involvement in good work can self-transformation be achieved. Service activities which are regularly

undertaken at Samithis for the transformation of the members and for the benefit of the society include visits to leprosy, correctional and old age homes, medical camps in villages, Narayan-seva, free coaching classes, vocational training for employability enhancement of the villagers, sanitation at public functions, fairs, and public urinal cleaning.


Nagar Sankeertan

Eye camp was organised with the support of a local hospital where about a hundred patents were tested and spectacles recommended. A follow- up schedule were also given to every patient.




Sai Protein and Panjiri
