Sub: Financial Discipline

Dear Brothers and Sisters, Sai Ram

One of the important points of Discipline in the Sri Sathya Sai Organisations is the financial discipline.

It is very clearly stated in the Charter and Rules and Regulations of the Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organisations that no member of the Organisation will solicit any money from anyone for the purposes of the organisation or in the name of the Organisation.

No Samithi will own any immovable property and no Samithi will possess a bank account.

No Sai Samithi or a Bhajan centre will have a donation box and or any kind of hundi.

It is made very clear that all voluntary donations will be routed thru the Sri Sathya Sai State Trust and coordinated by the State President under his supervision.

All transactions routed thru the State Trust will be transparent and all accounts will be made available to the general public and especially to the donors. All immovable properties will be in the name of the State Trust.

I have to mention that discipline is of utmost importance and any violation will not be accepted.

Please ensure that all existing aberrations to this fact are corrected with immediate effect.
