The whole world and mankind is suffering a tough time due to the Covid 19 pandemic. Its been more than 90 days that the whole activity pattern across every domain has changed. Even the Sathya Sai Organisation had to face the heat of such times, But in spite of all the odds with the grace of Bhagwan Baba our organization at Haryana and Chandigarh has put all efforts to do whatever good they could do for the whole mankind and the people in need. Even covid 19 could not place any barrier and it feels so good to see people making their house a temple – doing seva in the form of rigorous prayers and sessions as held by the state continuously.

The **Guru Purnima Festival** this year saw a new face of spiritual activities taken up across the state.

With the Divine Grace of Bhagwan Baba the state had planned “**Shirdi Sai Satcharitra Parayanam**” which started on 5th June 2020 and it was decided to have the samapann of this parayanam on the **auspicious day of Guru Purnima on 5th July 2020**. Good number of participation was seen in all the districts of the state.

The State of Haryana and Chandigarh comprises of 13 Districts – namely Ambala, Chandigarh, Panchkula, Rewari, Rohtak, Jind, Sirsa, Yamunanagar, Kurukshetra, Karnal, Kaithal, Sonipat and Panipat.

All the districts participated in this month long yagna with full devotion and dedication. People did their parayanam with their family and friends from their homes.

On 5th of July 2020, Sunday being the Guru Purnima Day, people offered the samapann of their month long sadhna along with a collective continuous parayanam done on the day of Guru Purnima which started at 7 am in the morning and was offered at the lotus feet of beloved lord with Aarti and prasadam at 7 pm across the state.

The parayanam on 5th July 2020 was done continuously such that the lessons were allocated in time slots which started at 7 am and was offered with aarti & prasadam by 7pm. The districts also distributed Amrit Kalash & face masks to the needy on individual basis as per the instructions laid by our worthy AIP sir as we still have to abide by the government guidelines of social distancing.

District Panchkula held an online Suprabhatam and Bhajan in the morning from 5:15 am to 6 am. Samiti people distributed Amrit Kalash along with soaps & masks to the needy on one –on-one basis.

96 people joined for the parayanam such that this district offered 4 sessions of parayanam at the lotus feet of Beloved Swami.
