



Foreword from the State President

We are immensely blessed by our Lord and Master Bhagawan Sri Sathya Sai Baba to be able to place at His divine lotus feet, report for Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organisations, Mumbai Metro Region for the period January 2020 to December 2020.

YEAR 2020 – This has been the year where the entire world was faced with the onslaught of Covid Pandemic. Majority of the period was under lockdown. All religious institutions were shut down as a consequence both “Dharmakshetra” and “Sai Prem” were also closed.

This however was a period gifted by Swami to all the devotees to have self-introspection and spiritual pursuits majority of activities like Study circle, Bhajans, Balvikas etc went online without any interruption.

There was a spurt in online discourses by devotees from across the world sharing their personal experiences with Bhagawan. This spiritual activity has found so much merit that all across MMR state, different districts arranged different speakers and thus gave opportunity to devotees to experience the Bliss of Bhagawan’s Leelas sitting in the comforts of their homes.

- * Moorthy Sthapana – Sri Sathya Sai Trust Maharashtra along with Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organisations of MMR took this opportunity of lockdown to renovate a large part of Dharmakshetra. Prana Pratishtha of a marble Moorthy of beloved Swami has been done in Shantideep in Dharmakshetra where regular poojas are being performed.*
- * Vata Vruksh planting – 9 saplings of Vata Vriksha were brought from Puttaparthi and have been planted in different locations in MMR.*
- * Sai Food Kits – During Pandemic Lockdown, wherever possible, Samithies undertook distribution of Sai Food Kits received from Dharmakshetra, to the needy people. By the Divine Grace and Blessings of Bhagawan, a total number of 20,550 Sai Food Kits were distributed till September 2020.*
- * Nitya Narayan Seva – Despite the restrictions, under special permission from relevant authorities, Nitya Narayana seva was carried out from Dharmakshetra regularly. By the Divine Grace & Blessings of Bhagawan, 1,16,250 Narayanas served till 31st December.*



Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organisations – An Introduction



The Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organisations, founded by Bhagawan Sri Sathya Sai Baba in the year 1965, is a service organisation with a spiritual core and base to benefit all mankind irrespective of religion, caste, creed or sect. The Organisation serves as a platform for its members to undertake service and other activities motivated by an urge for one's own transformation with the aim of realizing one's inherent divinity.

Without any distinction of religion, nationality, race, socio - economic status, either for those who work in the Organisation or for those who are served by it, the Organisation transcends all barriers leading humanity towards the ideal of 'Fatherhood of God and Brotherhood of Man'.

The concept of fees or membership subscription is alien to the Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organisations, for there cannot be any fee or subscription for one's journey towards his own self.

The organisation functions through its primary units called as Samithis and Bhajan Mandalis of which individuals - from different strata of society, different ethnic groups pursuing different religions and faiths -are members bound by the dictum of "Love all, Serve All" and pursue their own sadhana towards self-transformation following the path of selfless service to humanity.

At no point is an individual asked to follow a certain religion or rituals. On the contrary each is inspired to follow his own faith so as to ensure that a Hindu becomes a better Hindu, a Muslim becomes a better Muslim, a Christian becomes a better Christian and so on. In fact, this spiritual basis inspires everyone to pursue his own religion better by putting into practice Love and Selflessness. That is why the Organisation features in its emblem the symbols of the major religions of the world.

The Organisations named after Me are not to be used for publicizing My Name, or creating a new cult around My worship. ... They must render seva (service) to the helpless, the sick, the distressed, the illiterate and the needy. Their seva (selfless service) should not be exhibitionistic; it must seek no reward, not even gratitude or thanks from the recipients. Seva is sadhana (spiritual exercise), not a pastime of the rich and well placed.

You must have the firm belief that the aim of this Organisation is to remove the obstacles that keep man away from God, that separate maanavathwa (Humanity) from Mlaadhavathwa (Divinity).. This Organisation must elevate the human into the Divine."

WINGS OF THE ORGANISATIONS

The Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organisation functions under three wings viz. (i) Spiritual, (ii) Education, and (iii) Service.

Each activity in a wing is directed to facilitate and help the member in his own spiritual advancement. Although, the nature of activities undertaken under different wings appear to be distinct and dissimilar, but there is an inherent interrelationship amongst all the three wings. The three wings stand for Worship, Wisdom and Work.

Spirituality and Service are supplementary and complementary to each other. Spirituality is the motivational force behind service and service is the fulfillment of spirituality. Therefore, spiritual concepts learnt through education must be put into practice in form of service to humanity. Thus, in order to successfully realize the objective of joining the Sai Organisation, one must participate in activities of all the three wings.

ADMINISTRATION OF THE ORGANISATIONS

Headed by an All India President who is supported by the National Vice Presidents and State Presidents, the Organisation functions like a well-oiled machine in the District under the stewardship of the District President, focused on its purpose, clear in its vision and dedicated in its efforts to live up the Swami's message – "Love All, Serve All".

The Samithis and the Bhajan Mandalis constitute a genuine spiritual movement where the members are united by a common bond – Love for God and Service to fellow human beings.

The members of the organisation work as one cohesive unit, whether as sevadals providing

service at Prashanthi Nilayam, at medical camps, doing Narayan seva or the BalVikas gurus who work with young children to inspire in them a desire to inculcate the five human values of Truth,

Righteousness, Love, Peace and Non-violence, or the teachers who having undergone the training in EHV help in guiding the young minds towards the higher goals of life or the Sai Youth who work tirelessly in the Sri Sathya Sai Village Integrated Programme and Sri Sathya Sai Vidya Jyoti Programme – each of them are bound by one goal – "Service to Man is Service to God".

THE 9 POINT CODE OF CONDUCT AND 10 PRINCIPLES

Every member of the Organisation is expected to undertake Sadhana (spiritual discipline) as an integral part of his/her daily life by abiding by the following Nine Point Code of Conduct which has been bestowed by Baba for one's spiritual and personal development. In addition, the ten guiding principles that forms the core of guidance for all the members of the Organisation as ordained by Baba himself are also produced hereunder. The nine point code of conduct and the ten principles are fundamental to the spiritual development of the members of the Sai Organisations

9 Point Code of Conduct

- Daily meditation and prayer.
- Devotional singing/prayer with members of one's family once a week.
- Participation in Bal Vikas programme by children of the family conducted by the Organisation.
- Attendance at least once a month at Bhajan or Nagar Sankeertan programme conducted by the Organisation.
- Participation in community service and programmes of the Organisation.
- Regular study of Sai literature.
- Speak softly and lovingly with everyone with whom he comes into contact.
- Not to indulge in talking ill of others especially in their absence.
- Putting into practice the principle of "Ceiling on Desires" and utilise any savings thereby generated for the service of the mankind.


10 Guiding Principles

- Treat as sacred the land in which you were born. Have patriotism to your nation - but do not criticize other nations or put others down. Not even in your thoughts or dreams should you think of bringing grief to your country.
- Respect all religions equally.
- Recognise humanity as one family - treat everyone as a family member - love all
- Keep your house and surroundings clean -as this will promote hygiene and health.
- Practice charity - but do not encourage beggars by giving money. Provide food, clothing, shelter and help them on other ways (do not encourage laziness)
- Never give a bribe or take bribe - never give in to corruption.
- Curb envy and jealousy; expand your vision and outlook, Treat all equally regardless of caste or creed.
- Be self-reliant. You may be wealthy and have servants to do your bidding, but service to security must be done by yourself.
- Have and cultivate 'Love for God and fear of sin'.
- Never go against the laws of the land; follow these diligently both in word and in spirit. Be an exemplary citizen.

BRIEF HISTORY

'Dharmakshetra', a Divine Lotus emerged from the uneven, hilly and slum area is a manifestation of Divine Sankalp and Love of His Holiness Bhagawan Sri Sathya Sai Baba, who laid its foundation on 3rd November 1967 in the City of Mumbai and declared that it would be ready on 12th May 1968. Dharmakshetra symbolises the core message of Bhagawan to Mankind, "to embark upon Dharma, experience Prashanthi and regale in Paramanand". Dharmakshetra signifies the mystical journey from 'I to We', from 'We to He', under His Supreme Guidance. This journey is from 'Without to Within', from 'Untruth to Truth', from 'Kurukshetra-the battlefield of Sensual pleasures to Dharmakshetra-the Realm of Righteousness'.









OVERVIEW

Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organisations is functional in Mumbai Metro Region with eight Districts with members from various cross sections of society and different faiths. With around 34 Samithis, the Organisation serves as a platform for its members to undertake spiritual practices through its various wings such as spiritual, education and service for their own betterment.

The thrust is on self-transformation for it is only individual transformation that would ultimately lead to global transformation.

ACTIVITIES

The members of the Organisation are involved in various activities on regular basis which primarily includes Spiritual Study Circles, Community Bhajan, Nagarsankirtan through the spiritual wing; Bal-Vikas and Parenting programmes through the Education Wing and various service activities through the service wing. Importance is given to regular service activities as only through constant involvement in good work can self-transformation be achieved.

Service activities which are regularly undertaken at samithis for the transformation of the members and for the benefit of the society include visits to leprosy, correctional and old age homes, medical camps in villages, Narayan-seva, free coaching classes, vocational training for employability enhancement of the villagers, sanitation at public functions, fairs and public urinal cleaning.





Sa – Forbearance, Compassion, Love


Tha – Modesty, Shyness, Patience

Dr. C. P. Girishankar, an expert attitudinal trainer spoke and guided the students and parents on how to make a ' Choice".




READING INSPIRATION DAY


The blue coloured office goers of Mumbai are used to receiving their lunch boxes on their desk at the stroke of the lunch hour. The carriers of these lunch boxes known as the legendary Dabbawalas of Mumbai are the messiahs who reach these lunch boxes across the geography of Mumbai. They have become Management case studies in many premier institutions like IITs and even beaten Six sigma quality parameters.

Due to closure of offices in Mumbai on account of the Pandemic, they have fallen on hard times with no income. Ironically a few thousand “Dabbawalas” Who feed millions are going hungry.

On request, our organisation members from MMR was in touch with their chief Shri Subhash Talekar and after due diligence offered to help 500 Dabbawala families with Amrut Kalash to last them for 1 month.

MEDICARE IN DHARMAKSHETRA

“Human body is a Temple of Living God”. It should be kept clean spiritually and fit physically. Therefore, the Sai Message of “Manav Seva is Madhav Seva” is translated in Sri Sathya Sai Medical Centre. Medical Seva had a beginning right from the inception of Dharmakshetra in 1968, when doctors visited on Sundays, bringing their own kits and medicines, and met with patients in an open shed. A better equipped Sri Sathya Sai clinic was inaugurated by Bhagawan Baba in 1974. The Sathya Sai Eye Care Centre was set up on October 15th 1995, the Eye Hospital has a fully equipped operation theatre and the O. P. D functions six days in a week. The “Giving sight programme” concentrates on intraocular Lens Implant Surgery and Eye Donation clinics. The Allopathic treatment available earlier was expanded to include Homeopathy and Dental treatments as well. In 1990 a small operation theatre for Cataract operations was built with provisions for emergency drugs and oxygen cylinder. A new SRI SATHYA SAI MEDICAL CENTRE was inaugurated by Bhagawan Baba in 1999. This building has subsequently been further expanded in 2004.



Inauguration of Medical Block in Dharmakshetra – 1999

This Centre every year, caters to thousands of patients free of any charges. This Centre houses pathology Laboratory, Eye Clinic, Dental Clinic and screening facilities offering Allopathy, Homeopathy, Ayurveda as well as Vibrionics treatments.

Dr. Janaki along with Dr. Suwarna Koppikar, our senior most eye surgeon till date, were there from day one of the inception of this hospital.

And within a few months were joined by Dr. Kapadia, Dr. Janak Shah, Dr. Dastoor, Dr. Sangeeta and Dr. Deepa Paranjpe, our anaesthetist, who are doing selfless seva till date. Wonderfully assisted by a dedicated group of paramedical volunteers for more than 20 successful years.

What started off with just 3 to maximum 4 surgeries per day, now the eye hospital, with our Dear Swami's immense grace and will, conducts more than 100 successful surgeries in a month.

Along with our senior surgeons, many New eye specialists have joined the hospital, which helps cases of Squint, DCR, YagLazer, Pterygium, Chalazion, Cyst removal, Epilation, etc.

MOBILE MEDICAL PROJECT



The Sri Sathya Sai Books & Publication Trust has been engaged over the last several years in various service activities covering a wide and vast spectrum for the upliftment and benefit of society, particularly the needy and under privileged.

A major initiative undertaken by the Sri Sathya Sai Books & Publications Trust, Maharashtra from April 2007 is to provide Primary & Preventive healthcare to the needy and under privileged including free medicines to all.

The Mobile Medicare Project also has been active in Secondary & Tertiary care and over the last 6 years, organized several specialized camps e.g. Ophthalmic, Pediatric, Gynaecology, Cardiac, Dental camps etc. A major effort has been taken to fight malnutrition which effects the growth & health of children. The malnourished children are treated in a very systematic & professional manner with no compromise in quality. The children are provided with Protein Biscuits, Tonics and other nutritional supplements and monitored continuously to watch their progress. Medical Camps are being conducted on a regular basis at Village, Tribal and Unaided Schools where issues relating to over all upliftment of the quality of life of the children are under taken.

The medical aspects of the Project are managed in a highly transparent and professional manner. Case papers for each patient, daily visit scroll sheets, patient's register, medicines requisitions etc. are maintained.

The Sri Sathya Sai Mobile Project is committed to helping the poor and suffering segment of society through high quality of medical aid by providing a wide range of medical facilities & treatment totally free of cost. The need for such major efforts is further strengthened because of the ever increasing cost of medicines and medical treatment







The celebrations concluded on the occasion of Easwaramma Day with Bhajans, Story Telling, presenting Greeting Cards and Balvikas Pledge.




Worli Sai Family Celebrated Guru Pournima this year virtually on 5th July 2020.

With the divine blessings of Lord Sai Krishna, Balvikas children of **Worli** had an online Krishna Janmashtami Celebrations on 12th August 2020.






MAHASHIVARATRI




GANESH CHATURTHI

However, a small group of 4 volunteers lead by Shri Rakesh Kad, prepared lunch prasadam for around 200 cancer patients and their relatives at Bharat Sevashram Sangh, Vashigaon, where Narayan Seva is being done from January 2020 on every 3rd Sunday.

Had this offering being cancelled, it would have been difficult for the authorities there to arrange for an alternative in the last minute. The Swamiji, who heads the Institution at Vashigaon and who has had our dear Bhagawan's darshan at Mumbai in 1982, thanked Swami for the prasadam and so did the patients and their relatives who had already formed a line to partake the lunch prasadam.

BRIEF HISTORY

Palghar district comprises of 5 Samithis i.e. Vasai, Boisar, Khardi-Virar, Virar and Mira Road, and was formerly part of Thane District. Palghar District came into existence on 18th December, 2016 for smooth functioning, easy participation in programs and for conducting Samithi meetings.

Vasai Samithi was the first samithi formed in Palghar district by the District President of Thane in the year 1990.

Boisar Samithi was formerly inaugurated by Shri G.V. Rao, the District Coordinator from Thane District on Sunday, the 13th November, 1994. Before formation of Boisar Samithi, some of the devotees had formed a Bhajan Mandali and were regularly conducting Bhajans, Balvikas and Seva activities in TAPS and BARC colony of Boisar. This Bhajan Mandali later on became a Samithi.

The Balvikas and Gram Seva activities conducted by Devotees of Boisar Samithi in village Makadchola included free coaching classes for needy students. Later on a Bhajan Mandali was started in this village under the direct supervision of Boisar Samithi.

Khardi Samithi was formed on the auspicious day of 15th August 2000 by District President of Thane.

Bhagawan Sri Sathya Sai Baba had visited Kaner in 1982. After the visit devotees from Khardi and other villages participated in organisation activities mainly in Balvikas and gram seva. Active participation in Prashanti seva and whole hearted devotion and dedication, raised it to the status of Samithi in the year 2000.

Virar initially started as a Bhajan Mandali with activities like Bhajans, Nagar Sankirtan, Gayatri Havans and other seva activities. Virar Bhajan Mandali became a Unit under Khardi-Virar Samithi. IN JULY-2020, DISTRICT PRESIDENT OF PALGHAR MADE VIRAR UNIT AS A SAMITHI.

In the year 2000, by the blessings of Bhagawan, Mira Road was officially declared a Samithi.

BELOVED MASTER'S DIVINE VISIT TO PALGHAR :

Our Most Beloved Bhagawan has visited in year 1982 with some of His chosen devotees to meet Swami Muktanand, stayed at Ganeshpuri, near Vajreshwari Temple, Vasai (East). During the visit Swami came to a village known as Kaner Village (very close to Khardi Village) to give Darshan to all His Dear Devotees present at the venue. 





GANESH CHATURTHI





BRIEF HISTORY

“Kalyan Samithi” is the oldest Samithi in Thane -2 District. It was established in the year 1967 by (late) Shri V.K.Naidu, Shri Rajagopalan, Shri Appa Rao & few other families of Sai devotees. It has completed over 50 long years in Sai Organisation. Dombivili Samithi was established in March 1968, Ambernath Samithi was established on 15th May 1994 and Jambhilghar Samithi was established in April 2018.

Dombivili Samithi was formed by families of late S/Shri Tijare, Gopal Naidu, Venkataraman, Tare, Ranadive, Rege and other Sai devotees on 8th March 1968. Last year, Dombivili Samithi completed the coveted milestone of completing 50 glorious years in the Sai fold.

Ambernath Samithi was formed by Mrs. Nair & family, Mrs.Ramaswamy & family & Shri Deshpande family in the year 1994. Jambhilghar Samithi is the only Rural Samithi in District Thane 2. It is located at a distance of 20 kms. on the road to Bharavi Dam Road in Badlapur, District Ambernath. The activities of the Samithi supplement the Sri Sathya Sai Gramin Seva Kendra where free coaching in Computer Training, Tailoring, Fashion Designing is provided to poor students hailing from the far flung interior areas around Badlapur, Shahpur & Murbad Talukas.

During the formative years, there were only a limited number of Sai families in the District. Presently, we have around 650 devotees spread across the District and the Samithis participate in most of the activities of the Organisation.

With around 4 Samithis, the Organisation serves as a platform for its members to undertake spiritual practices through its various wings such as Spiritual, Education and Service for their own betterment. 


BRIDGE ACROSS TIMES/CEMENTING THE GENERATIONS THROUGH BHAJANS:



Aradhana day programme was arranged online, Swami's Bhajans and Aarti was performed at the residence of all the devotees.


